Why Cleaning Supplies?

What is cozier than a home of your own that has everything you need to make it feel like a sanctuary? We heard from survivors that, **when budgets get tight, cleaning supplies are a major stressor**. If you have to choose between paying a CMP bill or buying laundry stuff, dish liquid, and bathroom cleaner (they always seem to run out at once!), you're going to pay CMP. Having a constant supply of cleaning supplies in the Free Boutique lets us relieve that need, without any worry.

















Remember:

Multiple jelly/jam flavors, lower sugar options, nonpeanut (like almond butter or sunflower butter), gift cards to buy bread (we only stock shelfstable items).

You can expand to include Fluff and Nutella, too!
